



## **CBOSS ANNOUNCES RENEWED CERTIFICATION WITH PAYMENT CARD INDUSTRY DATA SECURITY STANDARDS FOR SECURE E-COMMERCE**

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**BOARDMAN**, Ohio – CBOSS Inc., a provider of software solutions and services for e-commerce, payment processing and web portal solutions, announced that it has renewed its certification of the Payment Card Industry Data Security Standard (PCI DSS). PCI-DSS is a certification program initiated in 2004 by the four major credit card companies (VISA, MasterCard, American Express and Discover) to establish and help ensure the highest level of security standards for companies that process credit card data.

CBOSS' compliance is classified as a Level I Service Provider which means that, as a service provider, CBOSS processes over 300,000 transactions annually. CBOSS has been PCI-certified as a Level I service provider since 2007.

To meet compliance with the PCI-DSS standard, CBOSS is required annually to undergo a series of rigorous onsite audits by an independent auditing firm, self audits and extensive network scanning. To maintain compliance, CBOSS must provide an annual report to demonstrate that its IT systems, processes and policies continue to meet PCI-DSS requirements.

“Meeting PCI-DSS Level I compliance is by no means an easy task,” said Doug Carr, CBOSS General Manager. “But it is a significant milestone for us and provides assurance to our customers that we operate a secure hosting and e-commerce environment.”

CBOSS is both the vendor and service provider to the State of Ohio Department of Motor Vehicles' OPLATES system, the automated online service that allows motorists to renew vehicle registrations and order new plates. CBOSS processes all OPLATES e-payment data, close to one million transactions annually.
